DAY 01 ARRIVE DELHI

Upon arrival you will be met by our representative and taken to your hotel.

Overnight stay at Delhi.

DAY 02 DELHI - AGRA (by train)

Early morning transfer to New Delhi railway station to board Shatabdi Express for Agra, on arrival transfer to hotel followed by city tour of Agra.

Visit Taj Mahal - built by a grief-stricken emperor, Shah Jahan, as a memorial to his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal. Regardless of whether you see it ethereally floating in the moonlight, blushing in the rosy glow of dawn or reflected in the pools of its gardens, it is enchanting. It took twenty two years to build and the finest of skilled artisans inlaid the white marble edifice with precious stones and conjured a lacy stone screen around the cenotaphs of the emperor and his beloved.

Agra Fort - perhaps the most moving view of the Taj Mahal is from a little octagonal tower in the Agra Fort across the River Jamuna. It was here that the Emperor Shah Jahan spent his last days in imprisonment, gazing at the tomb of his wife. There is a gem of mosque and lovely pavilions in the Agra Fort. Later visit Sikandra - Akbar's tomb, a splendid specimen of Mughal architecture.

DAY 03 AGRA - GWALIOR (by train)

In the morning transfer to railway station to board Shatabdi Express for Gwalior, on arrival transfer to hotel, Later proceed for sightseeing tour of Gwalior visiting The Fort - Standing on a steep mass of

sandstone, Gwalior Fort dominates the city and is its most magnificent monument; Gujari Mahal - within the fort is one of the many marvels of medieval architecture; Man Mandir Palace built between 1486 and 1517 by Raja Mansingh.

Later in the evening we will take you to the Fort where you can enjoy Son-et-Lumiere.

Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 04 GWALIOR - SHIVPURI - ORCHHA (by surface)

After early breakfast proceed to Orchha, en route visit Shivpuri. Shivpuri is steeped in the royal legacy of its past when it was the summer capital of the Scindia rulers of Gwalior. On arrival sightseeing tour of Shivpuri - visit the Chhatris, Madhav Vilas Palace and the Madhav National Park: - 156 sq km with a varied terrain of wooded hills, the most easily sighted are graceful little Chinkara. Other species that have their habitat in the park are nilgai, sambar, chausingha or four horned antelope, blackbuck, sloth bear, leopard and the ubiquitous langoors. Later proceed on to Orchha. Upon arrival check in at Hotel. Overnight at hotel.

DAY 05 ORCHHA

After breakfast sightseeing tour of Orchha - Orchha's grandeur has been captured in stone, frozen in time; a rich legacy to the ages. On arrival check-in at the hotel followed by sightseeing tour of Orchha. Orchha was found in the 16th century by the Bundela Rajput Chieftain Rudra Pratap who chose this stretch of land along the Betwa River as an ideal site for his capital. Strewn around the area are little shrines and memorials, each with its own poignant
